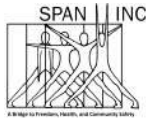

Description of tasks: *Pickers* read a prisoner's hand-written request and find appropriate books in our book store. *Pickers* are essentially personal shoppers for the prisoners. If you enjoy browsing in your local library or bookstore, this is the job for you! High school-level reading skills and a love of books are all you need to do this job.

*Packers* prepare the books for mailing. They read the prisoner's request and make sure that the books chosen by the pickers are appropriate and do not contain any forbidden items. *Packers* then wrap the books in brown paper – just like wrapping a birthday present – and prepare an invoice. People who can read at least at the high school-level, have legible handwriting and good attention-to-detail are great candidates for this job. Occasionally we also ask volunteers to help with other tasks such as processing book donations and incoming mail.
